



# Novena for One Nation Under God

The Lady of All Nations is a Catholic Marian title associated with alleged apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Ida Peerdeman of Amsterdam, who claimed to have received 56 visions of the Lady from 1945 to 1959. In 1951, the Lady of the apparition began identifying herself: "I am the Lady, Mary, Mother of All Nations. You may say: The Lady of All Nations or Mother of All Nations, who once was Mary." The following month the lady said, "The whole world is degenerating, and because of this the Son is sending the Lady of All Nations, who once was Mary." The Lady asked that the following prayer be said throughout the world:

### Prayer to the Lady of All Nations

**"Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father, send now Your Spirit over the earth. Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations, that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster, and war. May the Lady of All Nations, who once was Mary, be our Advocate. Amen."**

<p><b>Day 5 – Oct 30: John Hancock</b>, "All confidence must be withheld from the means we use; and reposed only on the God who rules the armies of Heaven, and without whose Blessing and best human counsels are but foolishness – and all created power vanity."</p>	<p><b>Day 6 – Oct. 31: George Washington</b>, "The liberty enjoyed by the people of these States of worshipping Almighty God, agreeable to their consciences, is not only among the choicest of their blessings, but also of their rights."</p>
<p><b>Day 7 – Nov. 1: John Jay</b>, "The Bible is the best of all books, for it is the word of God and teaches us the way to be happy in this world and in the next. Continue therefore to read it and to regulate your life by its precepts."</p>	<p><b>Day 8 – Nov. 2: James Madison</b>, "Congress should not establish a religion, and enforce the legal observation of it by law, nor compel men to worship God in any Manner contrary to their conscience."</p>
